

Outreach Committee Update

The SAA Outreach Committee remains excited about the cooperative effort of members to promote objectives as follows:

- 1. Reach out to local communities with the Gospel
- 2. Promote SDB churches of the South Atlantic Association
- 3. Promote outreach initiatives at each location and collectively as discussed by the SAA Outreach Committee
- 4. Partner with the Egyptian SDB church under the SDB Missionary Society
- The committee shares outreach ideas between various locations and has taken action such as: a bike blessing, Sabbath school in the part, disc golf outreach, revivals, health fairs and general acts of kindness. We encourage each member church to share outreach initiatives at your location with the committee. A key goal is to work cooperatively with West Palm Beach SDB to plan outreach activities leading up to the November Association meeting.
- An action was taken to develop a series of short promotional videos that can be used by SAA member churches to share the gospel and promote SDB's. We ask that member churches submit photos and video clips of outreach activities so that we can build a library of promotional videos for distribution. - We have started a partnership with the Egypt SDB Church. Monthly meetings are being held to pray and discuss how we can support their ministry. As an Association, we are supporting Egypt by paying the facility rental of \$100 US/month for 1 year. We have also raised \$1400 to start a bakery which will generate funds to help the church become selfsufficient. The Outreach Committee encourages each member church to adopt an international SDB church through the Missionary Society. This is a tangible way to spread the gospel globally.
- Although it is outside our scope, it is the consensus of the committee that the issue of abortion be addressed by our Association where member churches take time to speak to their congregants on the biblical perspective of abortion. This subject has been raised to the President for review with the executive.

South Atlantic Leadership Training (SALT) Update

The South Atlantic Leadership Training (SALT) for 2022 started in January and is expected to end in October, with graduation being planned for November 11, at the South Atlantic Association gathering.

SALT is a two-year leadership development program, but individuals can opt-out after the Primary (first) year and receive a certificate. Students who wish to proceed to the Advance Program (Year 2) will enroll in 2023. Then a new cycle will start, with the Primary year in January 2024.

The original plan was for modules to be in-person once per month, for eight months but due to COVID-19 monthly sessions have been on ZOOM, with the exception of one in-person gathering August 28, at the Daytona Beach SDB Church, Daytona Beach.

Completed modules are: (1) Growing Toward Spiritual Maturity, (2) New Testament Survey, (3) Biblical Beliefs, (4) Principles of Biblical Interpretation, (5) SDB History, and (6) SDB Polity & Parliamentary Procedures. Instructors have been Pastors Nate Crandall, Carl Greene, Nick Kersten, John Pethtel, Luis Lovelace, Garfield Miller, Jasmine Lynch, Andrew Samuels, and Janet Thorngate. There are two remaining modules for September and October: Leadership and Stewardship.

The 2022 program started with 30 students, now with the expectation that 20 will graduate. Generally, students indicate that the program is beneficial, but some are having challenges completing assignments. Please help us pray that students will manage their workloads towards graduating.

40 Days of Prayer Remembrance

A 2021 Devotional Guide for Church Revitalization & Spiritual Growth

Day 1

Avoid the Tragedy of Unbelief

Read Matthew 13:53-58 "And He did not do many miracles there because of their unbelief." Matt. 13:58 (HCSB)

This is one of the saddest verses in the Bible. It is the account of Jesus going to His hometown to teach. When people heard Him, they were astonished. However, their astonishment did not lead them to respond to His teaching in obedience and faith. Their lives could have been radically changed for the better. Their community could have been radically changed. However, no positive changes occurred in the people or the town of Nazareth. Why? The Scripture gives the reason, "Because of their unbelief."

Unbelief shuts the door on the transformational power of Jesus. Faith opens the floodgates to that same transformational power. In contrast to this passage of Scripture are countless others where Jesus worked miracles in response to the faith present in the lives of people. (Read Matthew 9:2; 9:22; 15:28; Mark 10:52; Luke 8:48)

When Jesus looks at your life what does He find? An attitude of faith? or unbelief? Do you believe Jesus can do a work of renewal and revitalization in your church? Do you believe He will? Do you believe that to the extent you are praying for Jesus to bring renewal to your church?

Prayer: If your unbelief is a roadblock to Jesus working in your church, confess the sin of unbelief. Ask God to strengthen your faith in Him. (Mark 9:24)

Day 2

Remember God's Power

Read Jeremiah 32:17-44 "Ah, Lord God! You Yourself made the heavens and earth by Your great power and with Your outstretched arm. Nothing is too difficult for You!" Jeremiah 32:17 (HCSB)

Sometimes we forget how powerful God is. We forget the great things that He has done in the past. We often allow the immensity of our own problems and challenges to overshadow the greatness of our God. Our view of God diminishes to an anemic, powerless God.

In order to build a case for the greatness and power of God, Jeremiah reminds us of what God has done in the past. He reminds us that God "made the heavens and the earth." What a display of power! God spoke, and the world came into existence. No one but God could do that. Creation itself is a testimony to the fact that God can do anything. Creation was just the beginning of God's mighty display of power. Jeremiah reminds us that this same God led His people out of Egypt with signs and wonders (verse 21). As we read the Scripture, we are reminded that this same God sent Jesus to be born of a virgin, live a sinless life, die on a cross for our sins, and be raised to life on the third day. Only God could do that! The death, burial and resurrection of Jesus is a reminder that God can do anything.

Have you forgotten God's ability to do anything? Today recall the many great things that God has done as recorded in Scripture. Remember the great things He has done in your life personally. Remember the great things He has done in your church.

Prayer: Ask God to do a work of revitalization in your church and your heart hat only He can get credit for.

Vegetable Seasoned Rice

Rice

1lb Parboiled Rice

- 1 Tsp Salt
- 1 Tbsp Vegetable Oil
- 1 Tsp Paprika
- 1 Tsp Turmeric
- 2 Chicken Bouillons
- 5 Cups Water Instructions

Combine parboiled rice, salt, paprika, turmeric, chicken bouillons, vegetable oil and cook until tender. Once cooked, put aside.

Vegetables

- 1 Red Onion Diced
- 1 Diced Red Bell Pepper
- 1 Diced Green Bell Pepper
- 1 Diced Celery Stick
- 2 Diced Carrots
- ½ Cup Frozen Green Peas
- 1 Clove Chopped Garlic
- 2 Tbsp Chopped Parsley
- 1 Stick Melted Butter

Salt, Pepper, Garlic Powder to taste

Instructions

Cut vegetables in small cubes and sauté in melted butter until tender.

Add salt, pepper, garlic powder.

Add additional seasoning powders as needed.

Taste to make sure flavors are blended well.

Combine prepared vegetables and blend to cooked rice.

Garnish rice with chopped green onions and parsley
